Where to apply: forward your application to the following office.

- 1. Eligibility: an applicant who is a Sri Lankan citizen by descent or registration.
- 2. Validity: valid for one month and one-way document only return to Sri Lanka.
- 3. **Criteria:** an NMRP can be applied only under the following emergency circumstances
 - The passport is lost or stolen, and the applicant needs to leave Sri Lanka urgently.
 - An emergency has occurred (need to prove the emergency with original documents as evidence) while an application for a new passport has already been submitted and is pending.
