 - Original Sri Lankan Birth Certificate which is legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Relations in Sri Lanka and a photocopy
 - <u>Government fee €25</u> per attestation.
- 3. According to the Birth Certificate and the Passport (birth certificate should be legalized from The Sri Lankan Ministry of Foreign Relations within one-year period)
 - 123 Form (Applicant's details)
 - Original Sri Lankan Passport and a photocopy

- Original Sri Lankan Birth Certificate which is legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Relations in Sri Lanka and a photocopy
- <u>Government fee €25</u> per attestation.
